



Welcome to Odsherreds Chamber Music Festival. For the 32nd time, we proudly present a wonderful summer week, where outstanding international musicians meet in Odsherred to create unforgettable moments of music.

This year's theme is **kaleidoscope**. When you look through the peephole of the tube, your eye will meet a magical universe of chamber music, winding in fabulous patterns and unfolding both jazz, tango, cabaret and folk music.

Therefore, the festival focuses on sharp angles and surprising concert programs. The evening concerts present classical masterpieces such as Schubert's Trout Quintet, Schumann's Piano Quintet and Brahms' 1. Piano Trio no. 1 being mirrored by rarely performed music such as Jessie Montgomery's Strum, Korngold's Suite for left-hand piano and strings as well as Erwin Schulhoff's Concertino for flute, viola and double bass.

The five afternoon concerts and the five evening concerts take place in the charming and modernly equipped concert hall at Anneberg Culture Park. Traditionally the afternoon concerts present the young musical talents - the stars of tomorrow - in cooperation with The Jacob Gades Legacy. Other program items in the afternoon include a walking concert in the historical surroundings of the culture park, a meditation concert in the church of Nykøbing, a concert for children in cooperation with Odsherred's Theatre as well as artist talks with the well-known painter Jesper Christiansen and the writer Pablo Llambias.

The festival ends on Friday, August 2, at 17:00 with a joyful concert, where the young strings of the festival together with Michala Petri will play a lively program with baroque music, new music and 'Holberg suite' by Edvard Grieg.
